TO ENABLE FORMER ENEMY ALIENS TO BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE AND
REMAIN OUT OF CYPRUS.

Short title. 1. This Law may be cited as the Deportation of Former Enemy Aliens Law, 1919.

Definition. 2. In this Law :

"Former enemy alien" means an alien who is a subject or citizen of the German Empire or any component state thereof, or of Austria, Hungary, Bulgaria, or Turkey, or who, having at any time been such subject or citizen, has not changed his allegiance as a result of the recognition of new states or territorial re-arrangements, or been naturalized in any other foreign state or in any British Possession in accordance with the laws thereof and when actually resident therein, and does not retain according to the law of his state of origin the nationality of that state.

Order of deportation. 3. The High Commissioner may if he deems it conducive to public good make an order requiring a former enemy alien to leave and remain thereafter out of the Island of Cyprus. Such order shall prescribe the time within which such person is to leave the Island of Cyprus.

Penalty. 4. Any person who having been ordered to leave and to remain thereafter out of Cyprus shall be found in Cyprus after the expiration of the time prescribed for his leaving Cyprus in the said order shall be liable to imprisonment for any period not exceeding three years or to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to both such punishments, and shall be liable again to be ordered by the High Commissioner to leave forthwith or at the expiration of any period of imprisonment.
