WHEREAS it is necessary to make additional provision
for the service for the twelve months ended on the
thirty-first day of December, 1923.

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Short title:
Appropriation Law, 1924.

2. There shall be issued and applied to the service of the
twelve months ended the thirty-first day of December, 1923,
an additional sum not exceeding the sum of twenty-eight
thousand seven hundred and sixty-seven pounds for de-
fraying the charges of the Government of Cyprus for such
period. The said amount shall be appropriated as
follows :—
