SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 329. THE MEDICAL REGISTRATION LAW.

CAP. 118 AND LAW 16 OF 1952.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2553

MADE UNDER SECTION 7 (1) (b) (i).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 7 (1) (b) (i) of the *Cap. 118* Medical Registration Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive *16 of 1952* Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Medical Registration (Recognized Qualifications) Order, 1952.

2. Any licence, degree or diploma granted by any of the universities set out in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a recognized qualification for the purposes of section 7 (1) (b) (i) of the Medical Registration Law.

3. The Order in Council No. 1715, published under Notification No. 1073 in the *Gazette* of the 13th November, 1936, is hereby cancelled:

Provided that any person who satisfies the Medical Council that he was a medical student at the University of Cairo or at the American University of Beirut on the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* or that he became qualified at one of these two universities within two years before such date and who applies for registration as medical practitioner under the provisions of the Medical Registration Law not later than the 31st December, 1958, may be registered as such medical practitioner and, for this purpose, the licence, degree or diploma granted by any one of the two universities aforementioned shall be deemed to be a recognized qualification for the purposes of section 7 (1) (b) (i) of the Medical Registration Law.
