THE SHEEP, GOATS AND PIGS (ENUMERATION) LAW,
CAP. 158.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 3.

A. B. WRIGHT,

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Sheep, Goats and Pigs (Enumeration) Law, I, the Governor, do by this Order prescribe Cap. 158 that—

- (a) all pigs (excluding their unweaned offspring) shall be enumerated between the 15th day of September, 1952 and the 16th day of September, 1952, both days inclusive; and
- (b) all goats and sheep (excluding their unweaned offspring) shall be enumerated between the 1st day of October, 1952 and the 3rd day of October, 1952, both days inclusive.

THE SHEEP AND GOATS (SHEPHERDS' LICENSING AND CONTROL) LAW.
CAP. 157.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 12.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 of the Sheep and Goats (Shepherds' Licensing and Control) Law, I hereby direct that during the period between the 7th September and the 30th November, 1952, flocks within the area of Kato Zodia, Nicosia District, shall, between the hours of sunset and sunrise, be kept inside an enclosure and not taken outside an enclosure:

Provided that nothing in this notice contained shall prevent the driving of any flock, under the proper charge of a licensed shepherd, from one village area to another, along any public road, at any hour.
