No. 404. THE MINIMUM WAGE LAW.
CAP. 215.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2558
MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Minimum Wage Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Minimum Wage (Shop and Office Employees) (Amendment) Order, 1952, and shall be read as one with the Minimum Wage (Shop and Office Employees) Order, 1951 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Minimum Wage (Shop and Office Employees) Orders, 1951 and 1952.

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Suppl. No. 3:
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2. The principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of clause 2 and the substitution therefor of the following clause:—

"2. The minimum rates of wages to be paid in the Colony in respect of the categories of shop and office employees mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be the rates mentioned in the second column of such Schedule:

Provided that nothing herein contained shall apply to persons employed in any shop or office in any village, other than a village which is a municipal corporation or an improvement area."
