ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2563  
MADE UNDER SECTION 124 (a) (i).

Whereas by an Order in Council No. 2550 published under Notification No. 306 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 23rd July, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") authority was given to the Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Councillors and Townsmen of the Municipal Corporation of Limassol to spend the unexpended balance of £6,210 specified therein for the purpose of relieving the housing shortage in Limassol town ;

And whereas the said authority was given on the condition that the aforesaid balance shall be spent for the construction of twelve workers' houses for the aforesaid purpose and it was found desirable that such specific purpose should be specified in the principal Order :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 124 (a) (i) of the Municipal Corporations Law, and of every other power thereunto enabling, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order that the operative part of the principal Order shall be read and have effect as if the following words were inserted therein at the end thereof :

" and that the aforesaid balance of £6,210 be utilized for the erection of twelve workers' houses in accordance with the plans and specifications approved by Government for the purpose of relieving the housing shortage in Limassol town ".
