ORDER

MADE by the Minister under Section 5 of the Preservation Act,
Chap. 15:04.

(Gazetted 28th January, 1993.)

WHEREAS Carnival in 1993 will be celebrated on the 22nd and
23rd February:

AND WHEREAS it is desired to make provision in accordance
with the terms of the Peace Preservation Act for the
temporary suspension during the period of Carnival of
certain prohibitions contained in the said Act:

NOW THEREFORE, the Minister in exercise of the powers
vested in him in the above recited Act and with the advice
of the Cabinet of the Commonwealth of Dominica doth
hereby order as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the –

Short title.

CARNIVAL ORDER, 1993.

2. In this Order unless the context otherwise requires –

Interpretation.

“fireworks” includes explosives locally known as bombs or anything of a like kind or nature;

“sensation type costume” includes a costume or any part thereof which is made of scraps of cloth, banana leaves, crocos bag or any other similar material;

“weapon” includes any firearm, cutlass, knife, stick, stone, bottle, (either empty or containing liquid of any description) and any article or thing capable of being used for offensive purposes.
