STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 8 OF 1992

ORDER

MADE by the Minister under sections 3 and 4 of the Stamp Ordinance (Cap. 277).

(Gazetted 26th March, 1992.)

1. This Order may be cited as the –

Short title.

COMMONWEALTH OF DOMINICA BOTANICAL GARDENS CENTENARY 1891-1991 COMMEMORATIVE ISSUE STAMP ORDER, 1992.

2. In this Order, the term “stamp” means an adhesive stamp for postage and revenue.

Interpretation.

3. During the period from the 30th March, 1992, to the 30th June, 1992, both days inclusive, there shall be issued throughout the State special Commonwealth of Dominica postage stamps (BOTANICAL GARDENS CENTENARY 1891-1991 COMMEMORATIVE ISSUE) of the values and colours specified in the First Schedule, and of the designs specified in the Second Schedule.

Stamps.

4. The dies and other implements required to give effect to this Order shall be destroyed together with all residue whatsoever of all stamps authorised hereby, as soon as possible after the 30th day of June, 1992.

Dies.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Adhesive stamps shall be as follows –

10 cents	-	Green, White and Brown
15 cents	-	Green, Blue, Brown and Purple
45 cents	-	Green, Blue and White
60 cents	-	Green, Blue and White
\$1.00	-	Green, Blue, White and Purple
\$2.00	-	Brown and Green
\$4.00	-	Blue, Green and Brown
\$5.00	-	Green and Brown
\$6.00 S/S	-	Green and White
\$6.00 S/S	-	Green, White, Blue and Purple.

SECOND SCHEDULE

The designs of the stamps shall be as follows –

10 cents	-	A CRICKET MATCH
15 cents	-	SCENIC ENTRANCE
45 cents	-	TRAVELLER'S TREE
60 cents	-	BAMBOO HOUSE
\$1.00	-	THE OLD PAVILION
\$2.00	-	FICUS BENJAMINA
\$4.00	-	THE CRICKET GROUND
\$5.00	-	THIRTY-FIVE STEPS
