# COMMONWEALTH OF DOMINICA MILLENNIUM COMMEMORATIVE ISSUE STAMP ORDER, 2000.

2. In this Order, the term "stamp" means an adhesive stamp for postage and revenue.

3. During the period from 31st December, 1999 to 1st April, 2000 both days inclusive, there shall be issued throughout the State, Special Commonwealth of Dominica postage stamps (MILLENNIUM COMMEMORATIVE STAMP ISSUE) of values and colours specified in Schedule I, and the designs specified in the Schedule II.
