STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 30 OF 1992

ORDER

MADE by the Minister under sections 3 and 4 of the Stamp Act
(Chap. 68:01).

(Gazetted 5th November, 1992.)

1. This Order may be cited as the –

Short title.

COMMONWEALTH OF DOMINICA MODEL TRAINS COMMEMORATIVE ISSUE STAMP ORDER, 1992.

2. In this Order, the term “stamp” means an adhesive stamp for
postage and revenue.

Interpretation.

3. During the period from 11th November, 1992, to the 11th
February, 1993, both days inclusive, there shall be issued through-
out the State special Commonwealth of Dominica postage stamps
(MODEL TRAINS COMMEMORATIVE ISSUE) of the values
and colours specified in the First Schedule, and of the designs
specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

Stamps.

4. The dies and other implements required to give effect to this
Order shall be destroyed together with all residue whatsoever of all
stamps authorised hereby, as soon as possible, after the 11th day of
February, 1993.

Dies.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Adhesive stamps shall be as follows –

15 cents	-	Deep Olive Green and Dull Yellow
25 cents	-	Sage Green and Gray
55 cents	-	Chestnut and Gray
65 cents	-	Dull Yellow and Olive Yellow
75 cents	-	Slate Blue and Black
\$1.00	-	Deep Blue and Black
\$3.00	-	Olive Brown and Black
\$5.00	-	Deep Blue, Red and Black
\$6.00 S/S	-	Gray Black, Black and White
\$6.00 S/S	-	Black, Bright Yellow and Green.

SECOND SCHEDULE

The designs of the stamps shall be as follows –

15 cents	-	BRASS RENO 4-4-0
25 cents	-	UNION PACIFIC GOLDEN CLASSIC
55 cents	-	LMS 3RD CLASS BRAKE COACH
65 cents	-	WABASH 2-6-0 IN BRASS
75 cents	-	PENNSYLVANIA R.R. T-1 DUPLEX
