STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS No. 11 OF 1998

ORDER

MADE by the Minister under sections 3 and 4 of the Stamp Act,
(Chap. 68:01).

(Gazetted 9th April, 1998.)

1. This Order may be cited as the –

Short title.

**COMMONWEALTH OF DOMINICA MUSHROOMS
OF THE WORLD STAMP ISSUE ORDER 1998.**

2. In this Order, the term “stamp” means an adhesive stamp for
postage and revenue.

Interpretation.

3. During the period from 30th March, 1998 to 29th June,
1998, both days inclusive, there shall be issued throughout the State
special Commonwealth of Dominica postage stamps (MUSH-
ROOMS OF THE WORLD) of the values and colours specified in
Schedule I, and of the designs specified in Schedule II.

4. The dies and other implements required to give effect to this
Order shall be destroyed with all residue of all stamps authorised
for issuance under this Order as soon as possible after the 29th day
of June, 1998.

Commencement 5. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 30th day of March, 1998.

SCHEDULE I

The values and colours of the stamps shall be as follows-

- 10 cents - Green and Orange
- 15 cents - Green and Light Brown
- 20 cents - Green and Brown
- .50 cents - Yellow, Green and Wine
- 55 cents - Yellow, Green, Black, Purple and Blue
- 90 cents - Brown, Green and Black

SHEETLET

- \$1.00 Green, Cream, White, Orange, Brown, Purple, Wine, Red and Yellow

SOUVENIR SHEET

- \$6.00 - Purple, Green, Black and Yellow

(Section 3).

SCHEDULE II

The designs of the stamps shall be as follows-

- 10 cents - *Omphalotus illundens*
- 15 cents - *Inocybe fastigiata*
- 20 cents - *Marasmius plicatulus*
- 50 cents - *Mycena lilacifolia*
- 55 cents - *Armillaria straminea*, Holly Blue Butterfly
- 90 cents - *Melitaea didyama*, Spotted Iritillary Butterfly
