MADE by the Minister under sections 3 and 4 of the Stamp Act, (Chapter 68:01)

1. This Order may be cited as the-

Short title.

COMMONWEALTH OF DOMINICA POPES & MONARCHS OF THE MILLENNIUM COMMEMORATIVE ISSUE STAMP ORDER, 2000.

2. In this Order, the term "stamp" means an adhesive stamp Interpretation. for postage and revenue.

3. During the period from 5th September, 2000, to 6th December, 2000 both days inclusive, there shall be issued throughout the State, Special Commonwealth of Dominica postage stamps (POPES & MONARCHS OF THE MILLENNIUM COMMEMORATIVE STAMP ISSUE) of values and colours specified in Schedule I, and the designs specified in Schedule II.
