ORDER

MADE by the Minister under sections 3 and 4 of the Stamp
Act, (Chapter 68:01)

(Gazetted December 7, 2000)

1. This Order may be cited as the-

Short title.

COMMONWEALTH OF DOMINICA
POPES & MONARCHS OF THE
MILLENNIUM COMMEMORATIVE ISSUE
STAMP ORDER, 2000.

2. In this Order, the term "stamp" means an adhesive stamp
for postage and revenue.

Interpretation.

3. During the period from 5th September, 2000, to
6th December, 2000 both days inclusive, there shall be issued
throughout the State, Special Commonwealth of Dominica postage
stamps (POPES & MONARCHS OF THE MILLENNIUM
COMMEMORATIVE STAMPISSUE) of values and colours speci-
fied in Schedule I, and the designs specified in Schedule II.

4. The dies and other implements required to give effect to
this Order shall be destroyed with all residue whatsoever of
all stamps authorised hereby as soon as possible after the
6th day of December, 2000.
