

# COMMONWEALTH OF DOMINICA

STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS No. 34 of 1997

## ORDER

MADE by the Minister under sections 3 and 4 of the Stamp Act,  
(Chap. 68:01).

(Gazetted 7th August, 1997.)

1. This Order may be cited as the –

Short title.

COMMONWEALTH OF DOMINICA  
WORLD CUP FOOTBALL COMMEMORATIVE  
ISSUE STAMP ORDER 1997.

2. In this Order, the term “stamp” means an adhesive stamp for postage and revenue.

Interpretation.

3. During the period from 22nd August, 1997 to 22nd November, 1997, both days inclusive, there shall be issued throughout the State Special Commonwealth of Dominica postage stamps (WORLD CUP FOOTBALL COMMEMORATIVE ISSUE) of the values and colours specified in Schedule I, and of the designs specified in Schedule II.

Stamps.

4. The dies and other implements required to give effect to this Order shall be destroyed together with all residue whatsoever of all stamps authorised hereby as soon as possible after the 22nd day of November, 1997.

## SCHEDULE I

Adhesive stamps will be as follows:

10 cents	–	Forest Green, White, Light Blue and Black
20 cents	–	Red, Yellow, Black, Green and White
25 cents	–	Gold, Brown, Pink and Blue
55 cents	–	Orange, Red, White and Blue
65 cents	–	Violet, White and Green
90 cents	–	Blue, Black and White
Sheetlet of eight stamps at \$0.65 cents each	–	Green, Grey, Red, White, Blue, Brown, Black, Yellow and Olive
Sheetlet of eight stamps at \$1.00 each	–	Grey, Black, White, Red, Yellow, Green, Blue, Brown and Pink
SOUVENIR SHEET		
\$6.00	–	Blue, Black and Gold
\$6.00	–	Blue, Black, White, Red and Yellow
