STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS No. 34 OF 1992

ORDER

MADE by the Minister for Finance under sections 23 and 54 of the
Customs (Control and Management) Act, Chap. 69:01.

(Gazetted 24th December, 1992.)

1. This order may be cited as the –

Short title.

**CUSTOMS ENVIRONMENTAL CHARGE IMPOSITION
ORDER, 1992.**

2. In this Order –

Interpretation.

“charge” means the Customs Environmental Charge levied under
this Order.

“tourist vessel” means cruise ships and yachts carrying not less than
twenty passengers.

3. (1) The master of every tourist vessel arriving at a customs
port from any place outside Dominica shall pay to the Comptroller
an environmental charge of two dollars US or five dollars and forty
cents EC per passenger on board.

Levy of charge.

(2) The environmental charge referred to in subsection (1)
is payable irrespective of whether the tourist vessel comes along-
side a dock or anchors off shore.

4. The master of any tourist vessel who contravenes section 3
is liable to a fine of five thousand dollars.

Penalty.
