# AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE DISCOVER DOMINICA AUTHORITY

(Gazetted 10th May, 2007)

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Commonwealth of Dominica as follows:

#### PART I PRELIMINARY

1. This Act may be cited as the

ACT 8

Interpretation

#### 2. In this Act

"Authority" means the Discover Dominica Authority established by section 3;

"Board" means the Board of Directors established by section 5;

"Minister" means the Minister responsible for Tourism.

#### PART II ESTABLISHMENT OF THE AUTHORITY

Establishment of the Authority.

- **3.** (1) There is hereby established an Authority to be known as the Discover Dominica Authority.
- Chap. 3:01.
- (2) The Authority is a body corporate within the meaning of Part IX of the Interpretation and General Clauses Act.

Functions of the Authority.

- **4.** The functions of the Authority are to -
  - (a) promote, assist and facilitate the efficient development of tourism;
  - (b) assign and implement suitable marketing strategies for the effective promotion of the tourism industry;
  - (c) encourage the establishment of amenities and facilities appropriate for the proper engagement of Dominica as a tourist destination;
  - (d) carry out market intelligence in order to inform the needs of the tourism industry;
  - (e) manage, license and supervise the Tourism licensing programme and other Tourism services in accordance with the Tourism (Regulation and Standards) Act 2005;
  - (f) identify training needs for the tourism service industry; and

- (g) do all such other things that in the opinion of the Authority, would facilitate the proper discharge of its functions or would be incidental or conducive thereto.
- **5.** (1) The affairs of the Authority shall be managed by a Board which shall be responsible for the execution of the policies of the Authority and for the general administration of the Authority.

6. The Authority shall pay to -

Remuneration of Directors.

- (a) each director of the Authority, in respect of that office; and
- (b) the chairperson in respect of the office of the chairperson,

such remuneration and allowances, if any, as the Minister determines.

**7.** (1) A director who has an interest in a company or concern with which the Authority proposes to make a contract or otherwise transact business shall disclose to the Authority the particulars of that interest; and details of the disclosure shall be recorded in the minutes taken at the meeting at which the disclosure is made.

Disclosure of director's interest.

- (2) A director referred to in subsection (1) shall not take part in any deliberation or discussion of the Board relating to that contract or business.
- **8.** A person is not qualified for appointment as a director if he is -

Disqualification of directors.

- (a) employed by the Authority;
- (b) of unsound mind; or
- (c) an undischarged bankrupt.
