ORDER

MADE by the Minister under Section 3 and 4 of the Stamp Act (Chap. 68:01).

(Gazetted 9th March, 2000.)

1. This Order may be cited as the -

Short Title.

DOGS AND CATS OF THE WORLD COMMEMORA-TIVE ISSUE STAMP ORDER, 2000

2. In this Order the term "stamp means an adhesive stamp for postage and revenue.

Interpretation.

3. During the period from 21st February, 2000 to 22nd May, 2000, both days inclusive, there shall be issued throughout the State, Special Commonwealth of Dominica postage stamps (DOGS AND CATS OF THE WORLD COMMEMORATIVE ISSUE) of the values and colours specified in Schedule 1 and Schedule II hereto.

4. The dies and other implements required to give effect to this order shall be destroyed, together with all residues whatsoever of all stamps authorized hereby, as soon as possible after the 23rd day of May, 2000.
