WHEREAS it is enacted by section 53 of the Commonwealth of Dominica Constitution Order, 1978 that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within the Commonwealth of Dominica and shall commence at such time as the President may by Proclamation appoint; and that there shall be a session of Parliament once at least in every year, so that a period of six months shall not intervene between the last sitting of the House in one session and the first sitting thereof in the next session;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that a meeting of the said Parliament for the session 2000-2001 should be held on the 2nd day of July, 2001 at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon at the House of Assembly, Roseau, Commonwealth of Dominica;
