CRIMINAL CODE (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2007

AN ACT to amend the Criminal Code, 1960 (Act 29) to change the reference "female circumcision" to "female genital mutilation" to reflect the actual nature of the offence, widen the scope of responsibility in relation to the offence and to provide for related matters.

DATE OF ASSENT: 7th August, 2007.

ENACTED by the President and Parliament:

1. The Criminal Code, 1960 (Act 29) is further amended by the deletion of section 69A and the insertion after section 69 of the following:

"Female Genital Mutilation

69 A. (1) Whoever carries out female genital mutilation and excises, infibulates or otherwise mutilates the whole or any part of the labia minora, labia majora and the clitoris of another person commits an offence, and is liable on summary conviction to imprisonment for a term of not less than five years and not more than ten years.

(2) Whoever participates in or is concerned with a ritual or customary activity that subjects a person to female genital mutilation commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to imprisonment for a term of not less than five years and not more than ten years.

(3) For the purposes of this section

"excise" means to remove the prepuce, the clitoris and all or part of the labia minora;
