CHAPTER 301 SENATE DISQUALIFICATION ACT

An Act to provide for the disqualification of public officers, with certain exceptions, from appointment to membership of the Senate.

[Act No. 5 of 1967.]

[3rd March, 1967.]

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Senate Disqualification Act.

2. Disqualification from appointment as Senator

No public officer or other person holding or acting in any public office shall be appointed or be qualified to be appointed as a Senator.

3. Act not to apply with respect to certain public offices

Notwithstanding section 2, this Act does not apply with respect to any public officer or other person holding or acting in the office of Attorney-General or to a person who is a teacher registered as such in the Teachers' Register pursuant to section 13 of the Education Act, Chapter 86.
