

This is an English translation.

The original Icelandic text, as published in the Law Gazette (Stjórnartíðindi), is the authoritative text. Should there be discrepancy between this translation and the authoritative text, the latter prevails.

Article 1

A new paragraph is added to Article 9 of the Act as follows:
The Competition Appeals Committee will not consider a complaint unless it is accompanied by an appeals fee.

Article 2

Article 16 of the Act shall be amended as follows:

The words “Articles 10, 11 and 12” in item a of the first paragraph are replaced by: the prohibition provisions of this Act, settlements or decisions that have been made pursuant to this Act.

A new item is added to paragraph 1 as follows:
circumstances or conduct which prevents, limits or affects competition to the detriment of the public interest.
Circumstances means among other things, factors
