An Act to enact certain transitional provisions, make certain amendments, and effect certain repeals, in consequence of the enactment of the *Telecommunications Act 1989*, the *Australian Postal Corporation Act 1989* and the *Australian Telecommunications Corporation Act 1989*, and for other purposes

Part 1—Preliminary

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Telecommunications and Postal* Services (Transitional Provisions and Consequential Amendments) Act 1989.

2 Commencement

- (1) Subject to this section, this Act commences on a day or days to be fixed by Proclamation.
- (2) Sections 1 and 2 commence on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.
- (4) If a provision of this Act (other than section 1 or 2) does not commence under subsection (1) within the period of 6 months beginning on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent, it commences on the first day after the end of that period.
