An Act to amend the *Telecommunications* (*Interception*) *Act 1979*, and for related purposes

[Assented to 3 May 2006]

The Parliament of Australia enacts:

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Telecommunications* (*Interception*) *Amendment Act 2006*.

2 Commencement

(1) Each provision of this Act specified in column 1 of the table commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with column 2 of the table. Any other statement in column 2 has effect according to its terms.
