## CASA 30/20 – Permission for Carriage of Dangerous Goods – Isopropanol 2020

(This instrument constitutes an exemption, issued by the appropriate National Authority as defined in ICAO Annex 18, ICAO Doc 9284 AN/905 and ICAO Doc 9284 AN/905 Supplement.)

### 1 Name

This instrument is CASA 30/20 – Permission for Carriage of Dangerous Goods – Isopropanol 2020.

#### 2 Duration

This instrument:

- (a) commences on the day after it is registered; and
- (b) is repealed at the end of 31 May 2023.

## 3 Application

This instrument applies to:

- (a) an operator that holds an Australian Air Operator's Certificate (*AOC*) (the *operator*); and
- (b) aircraft operated under the AOC of the operator (the *aircraft*); and
- (c) conducting flights between the ports approved on the operator's AOC; and
- (d) authorised representatives granted Operator Approval by the operator (the *authorised persons*); and
- (e) certain dangerous goods (the *dangerous goods*) specified in Schedule 1.

### 4 Permission

The authorised persons are permitted to consign the dangerous goods onto an operator's aircraft and the aircraft is permitted to carry the dangerous goods within Australian territory.
