FOR

AN ACT

To amend the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* and the
Acts Interpretation Act 1904.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate,
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
Australia, as follows :—

5 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Acts Interpretation Act* Short title and
citation.

(2.) The *Acts Interpretation Act 1901*, as amended by this Act,
may be cited as the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901-1916.*

(3.) The *Acts Interpretation Act 1904*, as amended by this Act,
may be cited as the *Acts Interpretation Act 1904-1916.*

10 2. After section ten of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* the
following section is inserted :—

“ 10A. Where in any Act reference is made to any other Act, and
that other Act is subsequently amended, then unless the contrary
intention appears the reference shall, from the date of the amend-
15 ment, be deemed to be to that Act as so amended.” References to
