AN ACT

To amend the Acts Interpretation Act 1901-1930 and the Acts Interpretation Act 1904-1930.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Acts Interpretation Act 1932. Short title and (2.) The Acts Interpretation Act 1901-1930*, as amended by this

- Act, may be cited as the Acts Interpretation Act 1901-1932.
- (3.) The Acts Interpretation Act 1904-1930†, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Acts Interpretation Act 1904-1932.

2. After section two of the Acts Interpretation Act 1901-1930

10 the following section is inserted:-

"2A. Where an Act confers upon any authority power to make Application of rules, regulations or by-laws, then, unless the contrary intention rules, &c. appears, this Act, except section fifteen A, shall apply to any rules, regulations or by-laws so made as if the rules, regulations or by-15 laws were an Act.".

- 3. After section nine of the Acts Interpretation Act 1904-1930 the following section is inserted:-
- "9A. Where an Act confers upon any authority power to make Construction of rules, regulations or by-laws, then,

(a) unless the contrary intention appears this Act shall apply to any rules, regulations or by-laws so made as if the rules, regulations or by-laws were an Act and as if each such rule, regulation or by-law were a section of an Act; and
