Relating to Primage Duties of Customs.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate,
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Customs Tariff (Primage Duties)* Short title.

- 15 4.—(1.) The time of the imposition of the primage duties imposed
by this Act, except in respect of goods in respect of which a later
date is specified in the Schedule, is the fifth day of October, One
thousand nine hundred and thirty-three, at nine o'clock in the
forenoon, reckoned according to standard time in the Territory for
20 the Seat of Government, and this Act shall be deemed to have come
