AN ACT

Relating to Primage Duties of Customs.

- E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—
- 1. This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Primage Duties) Short title. **5** 1934.
 - 2. The Customs Act 1901-1930 shall be incorporated and read as Incorporation. one with this Act.
 - 3. In this Act, except where otherwise clearly intended—

- "British Preferential Tariff" means the rates of duty set out in the Schedule to the Customs Tariffs 1933* in the column headed "British Preferential'Tariff";
- "Item" means Tariff Item as set out in the Schedule to the Customs Tariffs 1933; "the Schedule" means the Schedule to this Act.
- 4.—(1.) The time of the imposition of the primage duties imposed Time of imposition of Primage Duties. by this Act, except in respect of goods in respect of which a later date is specified in the Schedule, is the fifth day of October, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, reckoned according to standard time in the Territory for 20 the Seat of Government, and this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation at that time.
