AN ACT

To amend the Defence Act 1903-1914.

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :---

1.-(1.) This Act may be cited as the Defence Act 1915.

Short title and

5 (2.) The Defence Act 1903-1914 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Defence Act 1903-1915.

2. Section seven of the Defence Act 1914 shall be deemed to operation of 10 have commenced on the first day of August One thousand nine 1914, 1.7. hundred and fourteen.

3. Section thirty-one of the Principal Act is amended by Amendment of inserting in sub-section (2.) thereof, after the word "Aviation,", the word " Survey,".

4.--(1.) Section fifty-five of the Principal Act is amended by Amendment of 15 inserting, after the words "while on active service,", the words "whether within or without the limits of the Commonwealth,".

(2.) This section shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of August One thousand nine hundred and fourteen.
