3     The Parliament of Australia enacts:

4     **1 Short title**

5                 This Act may be cited as the *National Health Amendment*  
6                 *(Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme) Act 2012.*

7     **2 Commencement**

8                 This Act commences on 1 October 2012.
