## THE BOY SCOUTS AND GIRL GUIDES ASSOCIATIONS ACT

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Boy Scouts and Girl short title. Guides Associations Act.
  - 2. In this Act-

Interpretation.

- "The Association" means the Boy Scouts Association 27/1968 of Jamaica, incorporated on the 13th day of July, 1967, under the Companies Act:
- "Boy Scout" means a Boy Scout recognized as such under the Articles of Association, and by-laws and rules of the Association, and includes all officers of the Association.
- 3. It shall not be lawful for any person, not being under Unlawful the by-laws or rules of the Association duly authorized and unauthorentitled so to do, publicly to wear, carry, or bear any publicly to uniform, badge, token, or emblem which under the said wear, etc., by-laws or rules are specifically adopted for use under the etc. authority of the Association in such style or manner as to convey an impression that such person is under the said by-laws or rules entitled so to wear, carry, or bear such uniform, badge, token or emblem.

4. No Boy Scout shall seek or attempt by virtue of his Boy Scout wearing any uniform, badge, token, or emblem of the exercise or Association, or uniform, badge, token, or emblem purport- enforce ing or appearing to be such, to enforce or exercise authority otherwise otherwise than in accordance with and as authorized by accordance the Articles of Association and the by-laws or rules of the with by-laws and rules.
