# THE ELIMINATION OF FRACTIONS OF A CENT ACT 

[15th May, 1924.]

1. This Act may be cited as the Elimination of Short tide. Fractions of a Cent Act.
2. In all payments to or by Government officers where Payments the amount due includes a fraction of a cent, payment ${ }_{\text {Government }}^{\text {to orby }}$ shall be made as follows-
(a) Where the fraction is less than one half of a amount incent the fraction shall be discarded.
(b) Where the fraction is more than one half of a ${ }_{383 / 1969}$ cent, the fraction shall be regarded as a cent and payment made accordingly.
(c) Where the fraction is exactly one half of a cent the fraction shall be discarded if the number of cents is an even number or zero, and shall be regarded as a cent when the number of cents is an uneven number.
