THE FATAL ACCIDENTS ACT

1. This Act may be cited as the Fatal Accidents Act.

Short title.

Interpretation.

"benefit" means any benefit or sum of money paid or payable by a friendly society or a trade union for the relief or maintenance of a member's dependants and includes a return of contributions:

- "child" includes son and daughter, and grand-son and grand-daughter, and step-son and step-daughter:
- "insurance money" means any sum payable in con- 23/1979 formity with the National Insurance Act or under a contract of assurance or insurance whether made before or after the 7th day of September, 1979, and includes a return of premiums;

- "near relations" in relation to a deceased person, means the wife, husband, parent, child, brother, sister, nephew or niece of the deceased person;
- "parent" includes father and mother and grand-father and grand-mother, and step-father and stepmother:
- "pension" includes a return of contributions and any 23/1979 payment of a lump sum in respect of a person's employment;
- "person" shall apply to bodies politic and corporate;
- "personal representative", in relation to a deceased 23/1979 person means the executor or administrator of the deceased person;
