1. These Regulations may be cited as the Bath of St. Thomas the Apostle (Fees and Rates) Regulations, 1943.

2. There shall be paid to each director in respect of each attendance at—

- (a) a general meeting of the Corporation, the sum of \$2.10;
- (b) a special meeting of the Corporation, the sum of \$1.05.

3. There shall be paid to the treasurer at the end of each quarter the sum of \$2.50 and he shall be reimbursed any expenses reasonably incurred in respect of travelling in the performance of his duties.

4. Subject to the provisions of regulations 5 and 6 there shall be charged in respect of the services specified in the first column of the Schedule the rates specified in the second column of the Schedule.

Schedule.

5. Every director shall be exempt from the payment of the rates specified in the Schedule in respect of—

- (a) lodging for a period of two weeks in each year;
- (b) the use of the baths.

6. The following persons shall be exempt from the payment of the rates specified in the Schedule in respect of the use of the baths—

- (a) the postmistress of the Bath Post Office;
- (b) Mr. J. A. Halliburton;
- (c) Mr. I. Johnson;
- (d) any person who is, in the opinion of the clerk, in destitute circumstances.
