- (2) The Board may place on deposit with such bank or banks as it may determine any moneys not immediately required for the purposes of the Board.
- 11. (1) The Board shall, within three months after the end of each financial year, prepare and submit to the Minister a report of the operations of the Board for the immediately preceding year.

(2) The Minister shall lay the annual report before the National Assembly within three months of the day the Assembly next sits after

LEGAL NOTICE No. 27

THE CHILDREN ACT

(No. 8 of 2001)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 72 of the Children Act, 2001, the Vice-President and Minister for Home Affairs, in consultation with the National Council for Children's Services, makes the following Regulations—

THE CHILDREN (CHARITABLE CHILDREN'S INSTITUTIONS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2007

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Children (Charitable Children's Institutions) (Amendment) Regulations, 2007.

L.N. 145/2005

2. The Children (Charitable Children's Institutions) Regulations, 2005, in these Regulations referred to as "the principal Regulations", are amended by inserting the following new regulations immediately after regulation 3—

Duration and renewal of registration.

- 3A. (1) Without prejudice to the provisions of regulation 3B, the registration of an institution under regulation 3 shall be for a period of three years.
- (2) Every institution registered under these Regulations shall apply for renewal of registration in a prescribed manner upon expiry of three years from the date of initial registration, or the date of the last renewal of registration, whichever is the case.

Cancellation of registration.

- 3B. (1) The Minister may, upon recommendation of the Council, cancel the registration of an institution—
 - (a) if a programme undertaken by such institution is cancelled in accordance with section 71 of the Act;
