4. There shall be established in the municipality of Kitui a municipal council to be known as the Municipal Council of Kitui which shall consist of—

- (a) nine elected councillors one of whom shall be elected from each of the nine electoral areas specified in the Second Schedule; and
- (b) not more than three councillors to be nominated by the Minister under section 26 (b) of the Act, of whom one shall be a public officer.

5. The Local Government (Municipality of Kitui) Order, 2002, is revoked.

#### THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT

(Cap. 265)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by sections 5, 28 and 39 of the Local Government Act, the Minister for Local Government makes the following Order:—
