THE FOREST CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2021

A Bill for

AN ACT of Parliament to amend the Forest Conservation and Management Act, 2016

ENACTED by the Parliament of Kenya, as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the Forest Conservation and Management (Amendment) Act, 2021.

Short title.

Amendment of section 34 of No.

- Section 34 of the Forest Conservation and Management Act, 2016, in this Act referred to as the 34 of 2016. "principal Act", is amended by —
 - (a) deleting subsection (2A);
 - (b) inserting following subsections the new immediately after subsection (3)—
 - "(3A) The Clerk of the National Assembly or a committee of the House-
 - (a) shall review the petition to ascertain the petition whether meets requirements of this Act, the Petition to Parliament (Procedure) Act, 2012 and the Standing Orders of the National Assembly; and
 - (b) may request any relevant additional information from the petitioner.
 - (3B) Where the Clerk or the committee considers that petition does not comply with this Act, the Petitions to Parliament (Procedure) Act, 2012 and the Standing Orders of the National Assembly, the Clerk or the committee may give such directions as are necessary to ensure that the petition is amended.

(3C) The Clerk or the committee may reject a petition where the petitioner fails to comply with the directions given under subsection (3B)."
