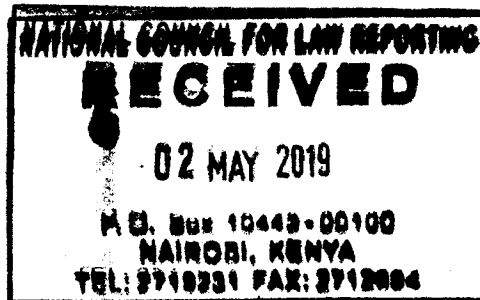

**A Bill for**

**AN ACT of Parliament to amend the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission Act, 2011 and for connected purposes**

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Kenya, as follows—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission (Amendment) Act, 2019. Short title.

**2.** The First Schedule to the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission Act, 2011 is amended— Amendment of the  
First Schedule to  
—No. 9 of 2011.

(a) in paragraph 1—

(i) by deleting the words “the President shall appoint a selection panel consisting of such persons as Parliament shall determine for the purposes of appointment of the chairperson or member of the Commission” appearing in sub-paragraph (1) and substituting therefor the words “the President shall, with the approval of the National Assembly, appoint a Selection Panel consisting of eleven persons for the purposes of appointment of the chairperson or member of the Commission;

(ii) by deleting the opening statement in sub-paragraph (2) and substituting therefor the following new opening statement—

(2) The Selection Pa;

(iii) by inserting the following new sub-paragraph immediately after sub-paragraph (f) —

(g) one person nominated by the National Council for Persons with Disabilities;

(iv) in sub-paragraph (3) by inserting the words—

**“within seven days of the declaration of a vacancy in the office of chairperson or member of the Commission” immediately after the words “President for appointment”.**

**(v) in sub-paragraph (6) by deleting the words—**

**“The Parliamentary Service Commission” and substituting therefor the words “The Clerks of both Houses of Parliament”.**
