CHILD PROTECTION ACT (CHAPTER 132)

CHILD PROTECTION (MARCO ALERT) REGULATIONS, 2016

The Minister responsible for National Security, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 148B(1) of the Child Protection Act (Ch. 132) makes the following regulations

1. Citation.

These Regulations may be cited as the Child Protection (Marco Alert) Regulations, 2016.

2. Interpretation.

In these Regulations —

"Act" means the Child Protection Act;

"alert" means a Marco Alert; and

"partners" mean the media, public and private sector organizations that aid law enforcement in the goal of recovering missing children.

3. Protocol for activating Marco Alerts.

Prior to the issuance of a "Marco Alert" and pursuant to section 148A(1)(b) of the Act, the Commissioner of Police shall in satisfying himself that a child is at risk of harm or death, confirm —

- (a) that there is reasonable belief that a child is missing or has been abducted:
- (b) that the child is in danger of serious bodily injury or death; and
- (c) that there is descriptive information about the child that will assist in the recovery of the child.
