## SCHEDULE

**LAWS OF MALAYSIA****Act 740****VETERANS ACT 2012**

An Act to establish the National Veterans Council, to provide for the registration of veterans and veterans associations, and to provide for matters connected therewith.

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Malaysia as follows:

**PART I****PRELIMINARY****Short title and commencement**

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Veterans Act 2012.

(2) This Act comes into operation on a date to be appointed by the Minister by notification in the *Gazette*.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

“veteran activity” includes the following activities:

- (a) organizing any welfare and socioeconomic programs for veterans and their dependants;
