

The Army and Air Force Reserves Act, 1950

(ACT NO. XLVII OF 1950)

An Act to provide for the constitution and discipline of the Bangladesh Army and Air Force Reserves. ♣

WHEREAS it is expedient to consolidate and amend the law relating to the government and discipline of the Bangladesh Army and Air Force Reserves; It is hereby enacted as follows:-

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be called the ¹[Army and Air Force] Reserves Act, 1950.

Definitions

2. In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,-

“prescribed” means prescribed by rules made under this Act;

“Reserves” means the Reserves of the Bangladesh Army or of the Bangladesh Air Force;

“reservist” means a member of the Reserves.

Division of Reserve Forces

3. (1) The Reserves shall consist of the categories specified in the Schedule to this Act.

(2) The Government may, by notification in the official Gazette, add to, amend or vary the Schedule to this Act.

Liability of reservists to military or air force law

4. An Army reservist shall be subject to the ²[* * *] Army Act, 1952, and the rules and regulations made thereunder and an Air Force reservist shall be subject to the ³[* * *] Air Force Act, 1953, and the rules and regulations made thereunder, in such manner and to such extent as may be prescribed.
