SUPERANNUATION ACT, 1966-1971

NAURU SUPERANNUATION BOARD

ELECTION OF MEMBER

WHEREAS Section 7. - (1.) of the <u>Superannuation Act</u> 1966-1971 provides for a Superannuation Board consisting of three members appointed by the <u>Cabinet</u>, one of whom shall be a person who is a contributor within the meaning of the Act elected by contributors:

AND WHEREAS Section 7. - (2.) of that Act provides that the election of the member to be elected by contributors shall be conducted in such mamner as the Cabinet, by notice in the Gazette, determines:

NOW the Cabinet here determines as follows:-

- 1. Leslie William Carlaw shall be the Returning Officer and shall, subject to the directions of the Chief Secretary, make all necessary arrangements for the conduct of the election.
- 2. The Returning Officer shall prepare a list, Department by Department, of all persons who were, or who became, contributors to the Superannuation Fund on the pay day immediately preceding the closing of nominations for the election.
- 3. Nominations shall be in writing and in accordance with the following form -

- 4. Nominations must be lodged with the Returning Officer before 4.30 p.m. on Friday, 3rd December, 1971.
