Enacted by the Parliament of Nauru as follows:

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the Oaths, Affirmations and Statutory Declarations (Amendment) Act 2020.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on certification of the Speaker.

Amendment of the Oaths, Affirmations and Statutory Declarations Act 1976

The Oaths, Affirmations and Statutory Declarations Act 1976 is amended by the provisions of this Act.

4 Amendment of Section 4

Section 4 is deleted and substituted as follows:

'4 Oath of witness in judicial proceeding

- (1) The oath to be taken by a witness in any judicial proceeding may be taken:
 - (a) in open court;
 - (b) as the court may direct; or
 - (c) as prescribed by rules, to be made by the Chief Justice.
- (2) For the purposes of subsection (1), the form of the oath is in Schedule 2.
- (3) Where a witness is required to testify through audio visual link, the witness shall take the form of the oath in Schedule 2.'

5 Amendment of Section 5

Subsection (1) is deleted and substituted as follows:

- '(1) Subject to subsection (2), an interpreter in any judicial proceeding shall take oath:
 - (a) in open court;
 - (b) as the court may direct; or
 - (c) as prescribed by rules, to be made by the Chief Justice.'
