**An Act to provide for the Erection of certain Public Buildings  
near the City of Auckland.**

## Preamble

WHEREAS by an Act of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Auckland intituled The Public Buildings Act 1875 (hereinafter referred to as **the said Act**), the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland and the members of the Provincial Executive Council, together with certain members of the Provincial Council, were appointed Commissioners for the purpose of carrying out the several undertakings authorized by the said Act: And whereas the coming into operation of The Abolition of Provinces Act 1875, will render it necessary that other provision should be
