

Regulations relating to a requirement to keep dogs on a leash in Svalbard

The purpose of these regulations is to protect people and the fauna in Svalbard from dogs that are not on a leash.

The translation is not official; it is provided for information purposes only. In the event of any inconsistency, the Norwegian version shall prevail.

§ 1. (purpose)

The purpose of these regulations is to protect people and the fauna in Svalbard from dogs that are not on a leash.

§ 2. (requirement to keep dogs on a leash)

Dogs of the breeds Samoyed, Greenland dog, Siberian husky and Alaskan malamute, and cross-breeds in which the size and temperament indicate that northern breeds are dominant, shall be kept on a leash or safely confined or fenced in at all times of year.

The Governor may also order that individual dogs of other breeds or crossbreeds than those listed in the first paragraph are to be kept on a leash at all times of year if such dogs represent a risk of injury to people or the fauna.
