Annually Norway sends a report to the OECD – Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development. The report "Immigration and Immigrants 2015–2016 – IMO Report for Norway" is a contribution to the reporting system on migration for the OECD countries.

The most recent report covers 2015 and to some extent 2016. It was prepared during the autumn of 2016 by the Ministry of Justice and Public Security in cooperation with the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs, the Ministry of Education and Research and the Ministry of Children and Equality. It is mainly based on figures from Statistics Norway and the Norwegian Directorate of Immigration and contains statistics on migration and on the composition of immigrants and their Norwegian-born children.
