PART I - PRELIMINARY

§201. Short Title.

This Chapter may be cited as the Judiciary Act 1983. [P.L. 1983-18, §13.]

§202. Interpretation.

(1) In this Chapter:

(a) “**judge**” means:

- (i) the Chief Justice or another judge of the Supreme Court;
- (ii) the Chief Justice or another judge of the High Court;
