An Act to provide for special measures to ensure the protection of ports.

WHEREAS it is necessary to provide for special measures to ensure the protection of ports;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

- **1. Short title, extent and commencement.**—(1) This Act may be called the Protection of ports (Special Measures) Act, 1948.
- ²[(2) It may, at any time by notification in the official Gazette be extended by the Federal Government to any port in Pakistan.]
 - (3) It shall come into force at once.
 - **2.** Interpretation. In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—
 - (a) "port" means "major port" as defined in sub-section (8) of section 3 of the Ports Act, 1908 (XV of 1908.);
 - **(b)** "protected area" means an area declared to be a protected area under the next succeeding section.
