THE NETWORK ANALYSER STUDY CENTRE (TRANSFER TO WAPDA) ORDINANCE, 1983.

ORDINANCE No. I OF 1983

[8th January, 1983]

An Ordinance to provide for transfer of the Network Analyser Study Centre, Lahore, to the Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the transfer of the Network Analyser Study Centre, Lahore, to the Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority, and for matters connected therewith or ancillary thereto;

AND WHEREAS the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

- **1. Short title and commencement.** (1) This Ordinance may be called the Network Analyser Study Centre (Transfer to WAPDA) Ordinance, 1983.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
 - **2. Definitions.** In this Ordinance, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—
 - (a) "appointed day" means the eighteenth day of July, 1981;
 - (b) "Authority" means the Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority; and
 - (c) "Centre" means the Network Analyser Study Centre, office of the Chief Engineering Adviser, Lahore.
- **3. Transfer of the Centre to the Authority.** The Centre shall stand transferred to the Authority on and from the appointed day on the following terms and conditions, namely:—
 - (a) the Authority shall pay to the Federal Government cost of network analyser, air-conditioning and other items of equipment determined on the basis of their original book value minus depreciation at the rate of 3.3 percent per annum from the date of commissioning;
 - (b) the ownership of land and buildings shall continue to be retained by the Federal Government and no rent shall be charged from the Authority on this account, but the Government may construct office building for the Office of Pakistan Commissioner for Indus Waters at the vacant premises of the Centre as and when considered necessary; and
 - (c) the Authority, if required, shall promptly carry out studies at the Centre for the Federal Government free of cost.
