

# [ PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1166, June 24, 1977 ]

## AMENDING THE 94TH ARTICLE OF THE ARTICLES OF WAR

**WHEREAS** in order to effectively enforce discipline and administer justice among all members of the Armed Forces, it is necessary that certain provisions of the Articles of War be amended;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS**, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Constitution, do hereby order and decree as part of the law of the land the following:

*"Provided, That in time of peace, officers and enlisted men of the Philippine Constabulary shall not be triable courts-martial for any felony, crime, breach of law violation of municipal ordinances committed under this Article."*

SEC. 2. *Effectivity.*-This decree shall take effect upon approval.

Done in the City of Manila, this 24th day of June, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven.
